

Graffiti Eater Soft

DESCRIPTION

Graffiti Eater Soft is a user friendly solution designed to remove certain types of graffiti from all types of delicate surfaces like plastics and perspex.

Graffiti Eater Soft has been specially blended to produce a product capable of removing graffiti caused by all types of paint, leather dyes and texta pens. Graffiti Eater Soft contains none of the Haz-Chem chemicals usually found in paint removers and is completely free of the very hazardous, caustic, formic acid and methylene chloride. Graffiti Eater Soft works relatively slowly to minimise any degradation of the underlying substrate. It has a pleasant scent which makes it suitable for use in occupied areas in buildings where members of the public are present.

APPLICATION

The method of application depends on the type of surface, size and nature of the graffiti and how long it has been there for, eg. graffiti which has been on the surface for some time will be harder to remove than graffiti that has not cured or has not been baked by the sun. Ideally removal should occur within 24 hours.

Apply Graffiti Eater Soft by applicator brush or spray bottle and leave in contact for 30 seconds. Apply more Graffiti Eater Soft in the same manner, repeating the process if necessary. As the graffiti breaks down, it is essential that the chemical and paint residue is wiped off the surface and the neutralising chemical Graffiti Eater Neutraliser is applied to prevent further chemical reactions. For heavily coated areas, or areas that have been subjected to baking by the sun, the process may need to be repeated.

Graffiti Eater Soft may not be totally effective on all graffiti as experimentation by the 'community artists' produces new 'cocktails' continually. In these cases, it is recommended that Graffiti Eater Ghost be used.

We recommend regular removal processes be undertaken rather than allowing the graffiti to build up, as the removal process will then be harder and more costly in labour & materials.

Ensure adequate ventilation during use. Wear Type A full face organic vapour respirator in confined areas. (Ref. Australian Standard 1715 - 1991). Avoid contact with skin and eyes, wear eye protection, Vitron or PVA gloves and solvent resistant overalls during use.
